As promised, below is the 2020-2021 company placement lists. Remember, EVERYONE needs to please check it because many of you who have never been on company before have now been placed in a company (especially our newest young companies).

A few things to remember/realize:

- We love the girls and these placements are not thrown together. Tons of consideration has gone into it. Please trust our love, judgement, and experience. We are purposely moving people around a lot this year to keep things in motion, to encourage new experiences and to encourage new friendships. Our positive studio atmosphere is top priority. Friendships are the best, and NEW friendships is what keeps us from getting exclusive and stagnant. Please trust us.
- For new first-time company members, just go to the fall schedule to see when your company meets. If you registered online, this company placement overrides the class registration. We will assume you want to do the company unless we hear from you otherwise.
- ALL COMPANIES **except Pre company and Shine** are required to take a hip-hop class on Mondays. Here are the details. We think you'll like it.

You attend as much as you can (decide if you want to attend beginning or intermediate). You make a ONE TIME PAYMENT of \$50 which ends up being about \$1 per class over the entire 2020-2021 season. When January comes, we will NOT KEEP TRACK of technique classes on the sticker board. We assume that your payment will incentivize you to attend as much as possible. In JANUARY we will add the Saturday technique classes that will also be covered by this payment in case Mondays are a bad day for you.

There is no choreography to be performed from the classes. If you miss, that's ok. But remember, the intention is to give you an almost free opportunity to keep your skills intact while we are creating choreography. And also, we want to help everyone get better at hip hop!

THE \$50 PAYMENT IS DUE BY OCTOBER 1, 2020 but please begin attending on August 17. Duncan is ready to teach you!

There will be a Jive PayPal option to make that one-time payment if you choose.

- Please remember we have our annual one-week summer break next week (August 10.) You can do make-up classes if or when you want. See you the week of August 17.

**DATE:** April 28, 2020

**SUBJECT:** JIVE IS OPENING!!

**MESSAGE:** We cannot thank you enough for your trust, support, and engagement during the past 6 weeks!!!! We knew we loved you before. We knew you were incredibly attentive and loyal students. But NOW it has been proven on a whole new level. Thank you thank you thank you for being the reason Jive can still thrive!!!

**OPENING:**

Yes!!! In accordance with the Utah Chamber of Commerce and the Safe to Work plan, Jive is OPENING this Friday, May 1. If your dancer has class Friday or Saturday bring them to the studio THIS WEEK!!!

**INCLUSION**

If your family does not feel ready to integrate just yet, we want to respect that. We will continue to live stream the classes like we have been through the month of May.

**SAFETY**

Jive will continue to maintain the sanitation guidelines of Utah County Health Department and the CDC including using EPA registered cleaning products.

**PROTOCOLS**

These 2 important protocols will be in place until further notice:

1. Parents, please drop off your dancers but do not come inside to watch from the viewing area. (Since we will live stream you can spy your kiddos from FB live while we dance!)
2. If your dancer or a family member is sick, please contact your teacher and keep your dancer home to participate via the live stream.

**CONCERT DATES:**

Even though we are returning to the studio, it is unclear and unlikely that the city will allow the Covey Center to seat people in large groups by early June. For this reason, we have no choice but to go to plan C for our concert dates:

**JULY 27-AUGUST 1 WITH SHOWS ON JULY 31 AND AUGUST 1**

We hope this advance notice will allow for a smooth transition into these dates. Of course, we are so sorry we couldn't predict this chaos and adjustment to the schedule. We hope that it is not a horrible inconvenience for any of you. It is always our intention to keep things steady and predictable for you.

**MARCH MAKEUP CLASSES:**

We have our beloved Miss Riki going on maternity leave on May 30th. Therefore, the 2 weeks' worth of makeup classes to replace what we missed during the final 2 weeks of March will be held in May (before Riki leaves) on the days and times on the makeup schedule: <https://jivellc.com/orem/makeup.pdf>

**SUMMER SCHEDULE:**

Because of the timing of the concerts, we of course have to practice all summer. For that reason, we will not shift our schedule during the summer. Class days and times will remain as they are currently until we go back to school mid-August. **Please watch for the fall schedule to post soon. You will be able to register for your fall classes by early July.** We realize many of you are going to take family vacations this summer and we will be flexible with that. Please just attend as much as absolutely possible.

**TUITION AND CONCERT FEES:**



Because of the uncertainty, those of you who have not paid for April tuition yet can do so without a late fee. You can pay online, by mail, or April and May together in person when you come in for classes. Again, thank you for your consistent engagement as we have continued to love giving you our best service.

If you still need to pay your concert fee, you can pay that now so you can be included when we send costumes home in the next 2 weeks!

**COMMUNICATION:**

If you have a question that you think is a good one for the whole class, go ahead and ask it in our text chats where I've been texting you about live streams (older girls with phones have been getting texts directly from me). If you are a parent of a dancer too young for a phone and you are not in our text thread, just email [oremjive@gmail.com](mailto:oremjive@gmail.com) and I'll add you!

Finally, we are so excited to feel your "in person" energy again! This distancing experience has taught a lot of lessons. One of them is how important true, human, face to face interaction is. Technology helps us so much when we cannot do that- THANK YOU technology. But there is no equal substitute for being "in person" with those we love and admire!! We are just SO HAPPY to be going back!!

**SUBJECT:** IMPORTANT CONCERT INFORMATION

**MESSAGE:** HEY JIVERS!!! I got some awesome news from the Covey Center today. Though our original May dates look unlikely at this point, they have offered us a new plan B option and then a plan C.

If we have to cancel our May 15 and 16 dates because social distancing doesn't give us enough time to get the show ready during live classes, our Plan B has changed from July 27 to the week of JUNE 8-13. We would use the whole week to prepare at the theater and then perform on June 12 and June 13.

If we aren't able to hold the show on the plan B June dates then we will shift to the Plan C dates of July 27-August 1 with shows on July 31 and August 1.

It feels so great to us to have a few options since none of us have any idea what tomorrow looks like. This gives us great hope that we don't need to panic or feel scared. We just continue to prepare and look forward to our AWESOME JIVE CONCERT!!! Never in the 24-year history of Jive have we been so excited to get on that stage!!! We need art! We need movement! We need entertainment! We need to do what we love! And we also need to be socially responsible.

So, keep tuning into the live streams! Keep preparing. Keep encouraging practice at home. Watch for an email about how we will get costumes distributed to you so they can get altered if needed! If you still need to pay for your costume, go ahead and send payment and we will include you in the distribution processes!

Geez talking about this excites us!!!! We can't wait for this show. How funny that the title of the show is "A Day in the Life" and follows a typical day (before quarantine haha or could you imagine the boring theme??)

Thank you to those who were willing to help out. We are so sad we can’t have you come. But we were so encouraged by how many wanted to.

Remember the class make up schedule we sent last week? (<https://jivelc.com/orem/makeup.pdf>) These classes are meant to make up for the first 14 days of social distancing we just had. We will still follow this schedule and make up for those last 2 weeks of March in person, however the dates of these schedules now need to be determined at a later date when we know we can meet all together in person.

We are still not exactly sure when we will hold our Concerts. We will know in the next 2 weeks. Just to put your minds at ease, if we hold them on the original dates, tickets will go on sale for all studios on May 4. If we have to push the shows to our later dates, we will push the ticket sales to later dates as well.

Soon we will come up with a safe and healthy way to get all the costumes distributed to each of you.

We are so happy that we have our Concert to look forward to. We always feel so touched at how amazing our dancers do with the preparation and performance. Imagining the intense emotions we will feel this year because of the unique circumstances is overwhelming even this far in advance.

**MESSAGE:** We hope all of you are catching your breath and finding pockets of peace amid all the craziness. As we all know, everyone is taking things day by day. None of us know how quickly we can get back to normal.

At the moment Jive is planning to hold our concerts on the dates originally planned. We've been in close contact with the Covey Center which is governed by the city. According to the Covey Center, the city has not projected out to mid-May and June yet. They are reevaluating the situation and make projections every 2 weeks.

We are excited though, to have confirmation that if we are not able to use the facility on the dates previously planned, WE ARE RESCHEDULED for dates a little later if we need it!!!! This makes us feel more "normal" at a totally uncertain time.

Alternate dates if necessary:

Orem Jive: July 27-August 1 (shows on July 31 and August 1)

Vineyard and Springville Jive: August 5-8 (shows on August 7 and August 8)

Riverton Jive: August 19-22 (shows on August 21 and August 22)

We are so happy that we don't have to cancel and only postpone if it comes to it! We can put our choreography, costumes, and months of hard work to use!!

In the meantime, we will rehearse from home until we feel we are in the clear to return to the studio. We are working to add poems for little ones and choreography for all dancers to our FB pages.

As of now we are still projecting to return to class at the end of March as the 2 weeks of social distancing suggests. If we aren't able to be back that soon, we will live stream the classes and new sections of choreography during regular class days and times for your students to participate as if we were actually together. We are looking forward to getting back to our awesome lives as we know all of you are as well!

We feel a sense of appreciation for the little normal things of life that have recently disappeared. It is a bright spot during bleak times to feel this appreciation. Stripping our lives down to the bare minimum is a powerful reminder of how the little extras make us the beautiful complicated humans that we are! Jive holds a perspective of HOPE over fear. We want to take some precautions but also do not feel intense panic at this point.

### **CLASS ATTENDANCE POLICY!!**

Dancers can miss up to 2 classes with each teacher from January- May. When a class will be missed, the dancer is required to FIND A SUB FROM ANOTHER COMPANY to stand in for them so that all the other dancers can properly learn group work and formations. The sub needs to be a dancer who can adequately keep up with the group. The sub is NOT EXPECTED to teach the absent dancer the missed choreography. Instead, the absent dancer is responsible to acquire a copy of the video footage taken during the missed class and COME TO THE NEXT CLASS CAUGHT UP TO THE REST OF THE COMPANY. This process will ensure that we can continue to progress each week!!

If dancers miss more than the permitted 2 times per teacher (EVEN provided they get a sub) please expect that the teacher will need to consider replacing the dancer in that routine, or removing her from certain sections. We take our concert seriously and need the awesome dancers to be in attendance so we can put on a great show. We know you understand!

### **FREE TECHNIQUE CLASS**

When we start learning choreography for our concert, we have no choice but to put our technique practice on hold and focus on our dances. We will be holding a FREE technique class offered to all company classes. These technique classes will begin on MONDAY JANUARY 6, 2020 and be held on:

MONDAYS at 4:00 PM which will be Hip Hop taught by Duncan

SATURDAYS at 11:00 AM taught by rotating Jive Staff (keep in mind that when we have Finalé practice on 2 Saturday's we will not hold technique class and it will NOT COUNT AS A TECHNIQUE CLASS ATTENDED!)

### **SPECIAL PRIVILEGE**

We are inviting all the companies in these technique classes to perform in the opener of our show. Dancers who attend at least 12 of the 31 technique classes offered between January 6th and April 27th earn this privilege to dance in the Opener. Students can attend these 12 classes in whatever way fits their schedules the best. They can attend more than

12 classes if they want, which is encouraged as their dancing improves tremendously with regular attendance. When April 27th comes, anyone who has not attended their 12 technique classes will not be dancing in the Opener. We will make no exceptions. IN THE PAST, WE HAVE ALLOWED DANCERS TO OPT OUT OF THIS PRIVILEGE. THIS YEAR WE ARE REQUIRING THE COMPANY DANCERS TO PARTICIPATE. We feel it is important for unity and makes rehearsing the choreography during class time more inclusive.

**OPENER COSTUME**

We need to commit, order, and pay for costumes in advance to have them in time for the show. Obviously, we won't know in advance which dancers meet the 12-class requirement. If your student doesn't meet the requirement by April 27th you will not be reimbursed for the costume as we won't be able to return them. We won't be able to make any exceptions. So please fulfill the minimum of 12 classes early in the season just to be safe.

**WHY WE LOVE THIS**

All the Jive staff has agreed that this addition of technique classes has been a great tool for our students the past 5 years. IT'S FREE! It keeps our technique at a high level while we learn choreography. It doesn't require a huge time commitment. It allows flexibility in working it in to busy schedules. All companies will be taking class together facilitating even more unity and friendship among all Jive company students.

**THOSE WHO WANT MORE INFO**

We just want to provide some information to help the process go as smoothly as possible. We realize that some of you have over a decade of experience with our concert process and totally understand and trust what we are doing. Others of you are new and want to understand. If you need clarification about what concert fees are and what they pay for, please keep reading.

**WHAT CONCERT FEES PAY FOR**

As some of you have heard us say, costuming is the most challenging part of this process. Imagine trying to please well over 700 dancers AND their parents on style, color, price, modesty AND at the same time, find costumes that are artistically and age appropriate and available in the variety of sizes that are required in a single class!! It is a challenge. We order such large quantities, that we must order by January to ensure they arrive by April to be ready for May and June. For those dancers who are still growing, it's very hard to anticipate growth from December (when we measure) to May or June (when they are worn). Please know that we do our best to guess correctly. But often it's off, somewhat. We apologize for that.

There are many expenses involved in putting on the type of professional concert that we do at Jive. The music is a huge project. It is professionally digitized with cuts, blends, edits, equalization and so forth. If you've ever been to a show with low quality music, you can appreciate the time and money put forth to spare our audience the pain of loud but low-quality music. Our video walls, and special effects cost time and money to produce. We also have the cost of unique props, precise and detailed lighting, reliable and competent stage crew, and hours upon hours of theater rental for rehearsals. To make it possible to produce the show, everyone pitches in. The concert fee is \$74 per dance that the dancer is in. A portion of the \$74 pays for a costume and a portion covers the above expenses. Ticket sales (\$6 to \$11 each) are also required to fund our show.

Thank you for supporting this process and understanding that we are ALL part of the reason our show ROCKS!! We are looking forward to a great year with you and your dancers. Thank you to all the Jive families for supporting this process!
